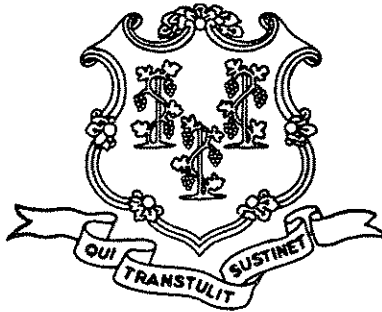

WHEREAS, members will continue to examine ways to encourage citizens to make informed votes and to contribute to the success of democracy in our state; and

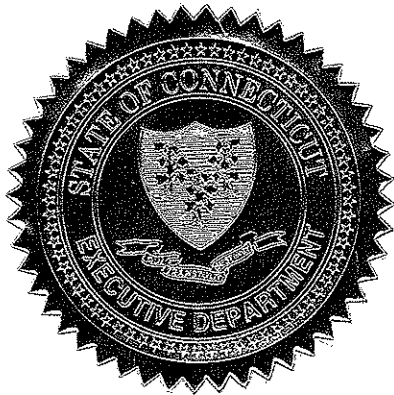
